

PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE REVIEW ICAN MOU APPLICANT

To become a Chartered Professional Accountant (CPA), candidates need to demonstrate a minimum of 30 months of qualifying practical experience and complete the education portion of the CPA program. As you have applied to the CPA Western School of Business (CPAWSB) under the ICAN Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), you may be exempt from the practical experience requirement; however, your file will need to be reviewed to determine the exemption.

Under the ICAN MOU, you are required to pass the Common Final Exam (CFE) and meet the practical experience requirements (term, depth, breadth and duration) to be eligible to apply to membership.

As you have been accepted into CPA PEP, you are able to begin fulfilling both education and experience requirements (there is no specific order they are to be completed).

In order to be eligible for exemption from practical experience requirements you must:

- Have two (2) years of post-designation accounting related experience and
- Hold a recognized university degree

To begin the review process, please submit the following documents

- Experience review consent form (this document)
- Up-to-date comprehensive resume (showing a detailed account of all related work experience).

Once CPAWSB receives all documents CPAWSB will provide them to your governing provincial body who will review, and a decision will be communicated to you. Should a full review be required, CPAWSB will inform you what additional documents are required to proceed.
